ORDERS BY THE GOVERNOR OF ASSAM

NOTIFICATION

Dated Dispur the 5th January, 2018.

No.AHE.488/2017/10 : It has come to the notice of the Govt. in Higher Education Department, Assam that the Director of Higher Education, Assam had issued approval of appointment letters to some Lecturers imposing condition that the appointee concerned will have to obtain M.Phil degree or a recognised degree beyond the Masters degree level within 8 years of his/her appointment. But some of such college teachers have retired from service without fulfilling the said condition, for which they are facing problem in getting Pensionary benefits and such condition imposed has resulted in acute financial hardship to the retired College teachers who have been given other benefites like CAS promotion, confirmation etc.

Having considered all aspects, Governor of Assam is pleased to relax the condition of acquiring M.Phil degree to the college teachers who were appointed on or before 24-12-1998 i.e. the date from which NET has been made mandatory for appointment as Lecturer.

This relaxation is applicable for only those who have retired from service and not applicable to serving teachers with such condition to get current benefits.

This will come into force with immediate effect.


