The rigorous survey encompassed 160 street vendors, a cohort predominantly constituted by males, with 93% representation, while the age demographic was primarily concentrated within the range of 30 to 50 years. The survey was conducted by the PG Department of Economics Pragjyotish College as a part of the syllabus of the ECO-SE-4014 data analysis on 31st March 2023.

Objective
The comprehensive study endeavored to elucidate the socio-economic conditions, demographic profile, and concomitant challenges confronted by the street vendors operating within the vicinity of Guwahati, the populous metropolitan district of Assam.

Research methodology
The study is based on 5 identified markets of Guwahati namely Fancy Bazar (east), Fancy Bazar (west), Kumarpara, Cotton University Front, and Bhutnath Bazar. Based on primary data the students went for a simple descriptive analysis is used to explain the real the problems and prospects of street vendors.

Key Findings:

- The survey covered 160 street vendors, with 93% being male and 56.25% in the age group of 30-50 years. 46.25% of vendors had completed higher secondary education.
- 76.85% of vendors lived in rented accommodations, while 23.12% owned their homes.
- Most vendors (86%) had been involved in street vending for over 10 years, with 65% renting their vending spaces.
- The majority (97%) had not received any formal training for street vending.
- Sourcing products from wholesale markets was the main supply channel for vendors.
- Vending was the primary occupation for 81.25% of respondents, and 72.5% depended on it for their livelihood.
- Key challenges faced included lack of government support, difficulties in obtaining licenses, competition, maintaining hygiene, and accessing water and electricity.
- During COVID-19 lockdown, vendors faced issues like maintaining social distancing, sourcing raw materials, and changes in demand. Most (85.6%) did not receive government support during the pandemic.

Conclusion
The report recommends creating more awareness about schemes and policies, establishing micro-finance programs, allocating designated vending zones with better facilities, and simplifying the licensing process to support street vendors.



REPORT OF NEHU

The Department of Education (M.A 4th SEM), Pragjyotish College has conducted Field Survey on 28th April 2023 at North-Eastern Hill University (NEHU) for VAC Paper-4074. North Eastern Hill University (NEHU) is a renowned Central University located in Shillong, Meghalaya, India. The aim of the study is to survey the present status of research under Department of Education and also to survey the achievements in the field of research under Department of Education NEHU. In this university the faculty strength is almost 300 members and intake of students roughly under MA is 48, M.Ed. is 50 and allocation of P.h.D. varies according to the availability of the seat. The undergraduated colleges affiliated to the university enrolls about 18,000 students per year.

From this survey, it has found that the university (NEHU) typically offers various programmes and resources to support the research scholars throughout the academic journey. 
The future planning of the university for the next decade is to open a Skill Development Centre to offer certificate courses in different trades that will help the youth of the region become skilled and employable.
