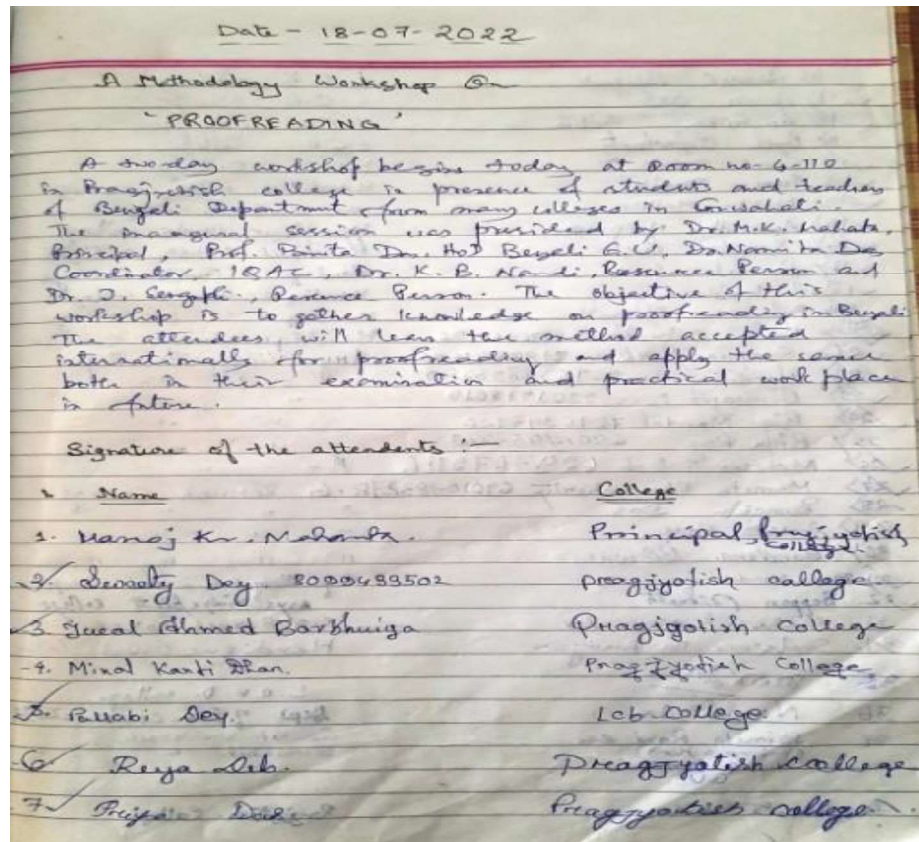

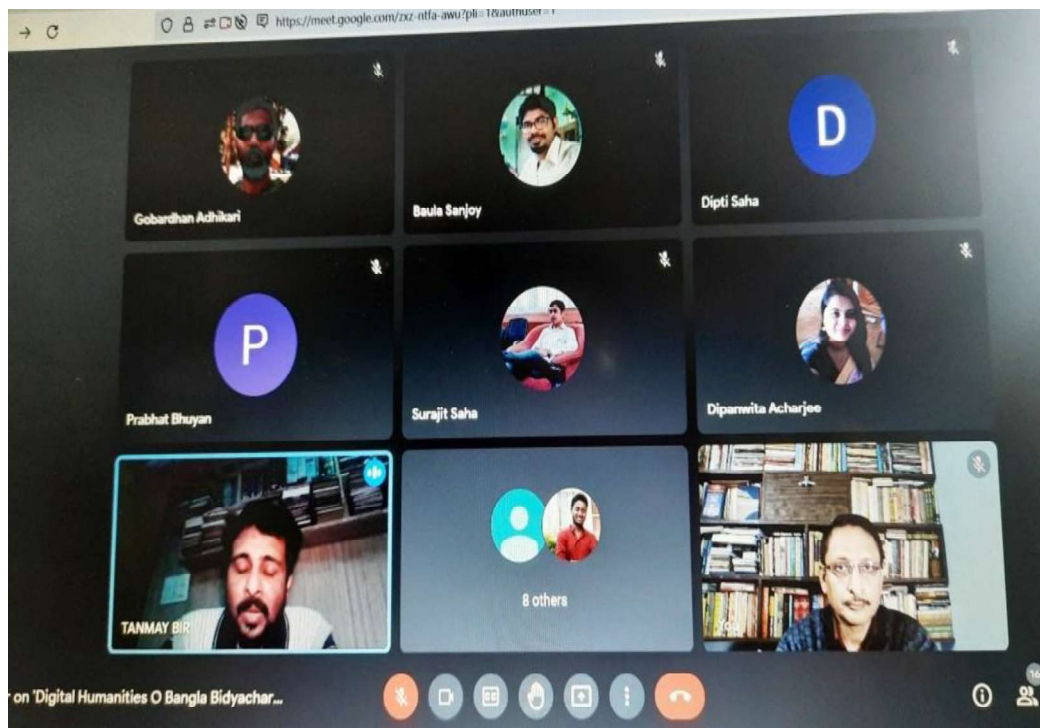
8. 'Digital Humanities O Bangla Bidyacharcha

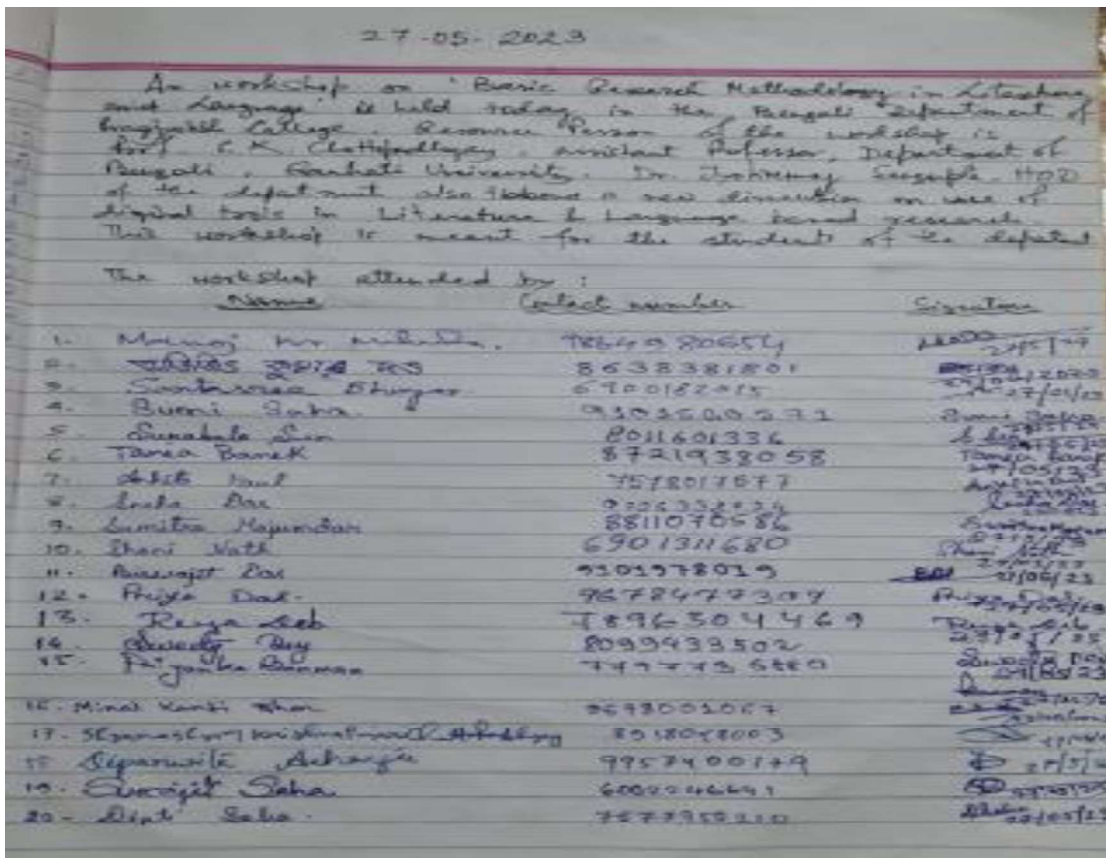
