



Anti-Plastic Campaign



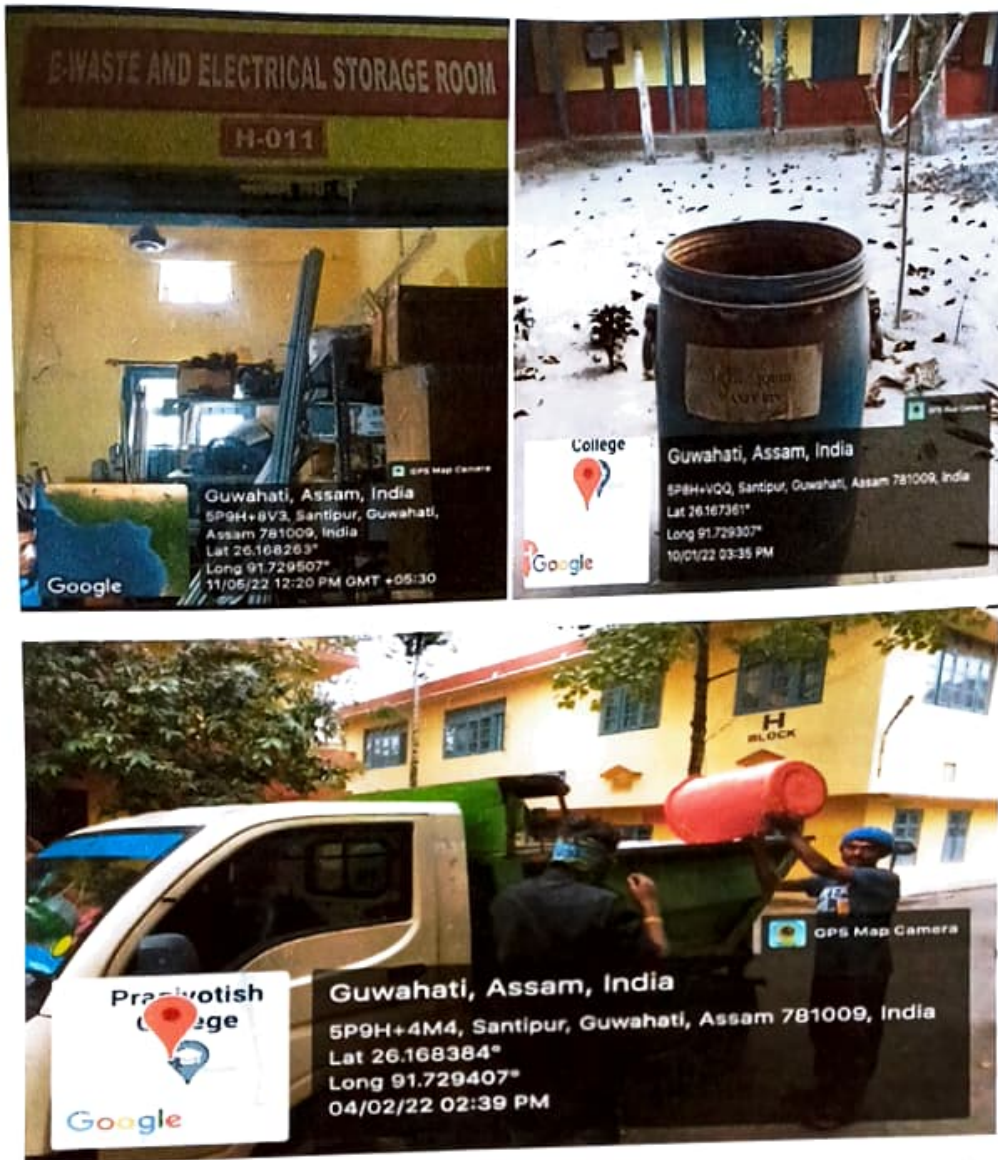
Anti-plastic signs were installed across the campus to promote the ban on single-use plastics and encourage sustainable alternatives.

Achievements


Enhanced Green Cover: Significant increase in the number of trees and plants on campus through various plantation programmes.
