

Copy of the Resolution:

The GB has gone through the General Feedback analysis report and has appreciated the efforts undertaken by the IQAC and Principal against the feedback collected and appropriate actions undertaken as per recommendations and suggestions of different stakeholders.

Resolution No 3 (A):

The GB has resolved to approve the payment of Rs 32,000/- for construction of Library E-corner against the work already done by the Principal.

Resolution No 3 (B):

The GB also has approved the payment of Rs. 1, 99, 990/- for purchase of 11 computers from DATACOM (10 for Library E-corner and 1 for Pragati Pathshala, the School adopted by the College) against the work done by the Principal.

Resolution No 3 (C):

The GB has approved the purchase of 10 Projectors for digital class room in Geology, Assamese, BBA etc. and Projector screen for Mathematics Department at the cost of Rs. 3,16,651/- paid to M/S Cyber Space) against the work carried out by the Principal.

Resolution No 3 (D):

The GB resolved to approve the payment to M/S Cyber Space for fitting of digital component at new Conference Room at New Arts Block along with the Furnishers (A total of Rs. 10,50,000/- is paid to Cyber Space) against the work carried out by the Principal.

Resolution No 3 (F):

2. The GB approves the construction of ground water recharge plant near Block-A building for feeding the rain water into the ground. The GB also approves the payment of Rs 1, 30,000/- (One lakh thirty thousand only) against this work already made by the Principal.
3. The GB approves the construction of tactile paving path for differently abled students at Block-B building. In this regard the GB also has approved the payment of Rs. 1,02,660/- (One lakh two thousand six hundred sixty six only) against this work already done by the Principal.
4. The GB approves the construction of a new toilet for LGBTQ+ toilet adjoint to the boy's toilet complex near auditorium. In this regard the GB also has approved the payment of Rs 1, 67,800/- (One lakh sixty seven thousand eight hundred only) against this. The GB also has approved the renovation of existing boy's toilet near auditorium at a cost of Rs 1, 38,000/- (One lakh thirty-eight thousand).
5. The GB resolved to renovate the toilet at first floor of Block-I near IQAC to prepare a separate room with attached toilet for IQAC Coordinator and authorize the Principal to do the needful urgently before NAAC visit. In this regard the Principal has placed a tentative budget of Rs 1,80,000/- (One lakh eighty thousand) including tiles fitting, painting, fitting of new toilet pan, partition wall etc.
6. The GB approves the expenditure incurred in completing the new borewell near Block-H (Near old Arts Block) which was urgently done by the Construction Committee due to acute crisis of water supply.
7. The GB approves the expenditure incurred in replacing the existing water tank from Block-A to Block-E (top floor of RUSA) which was urgently done by the Construction Committee due to dilapidated condition of the previous tank.

In its Agenda Item No-5, the Principal has placed before the GB the following items with approval of Governing Body President for discussion and approval-

- d. Proposal for e-siksha
- e. Proposal for food court and Nestle Centre

After threadbare discussions the GB has taken the following resolutions:

Resolution No 5:

- D. The GB discussed the proposal given by e-shiksha for ERP and online facilities in the college for office and academic purposes. After thorough discussions the GB has resolved not to accept the proposal as the college has already installed ERP for office and academic purposes and Govt. of Assam is also providing the online facilities through SAMARTH e-portal.
- E. The GB has resolved to grant permission to open the sell counter by Nestle in the college premise at a rental basis with quality food products with nominal price for the student community. The GB has reserved the decision on opening food court inside the college campus at present considering the space constrain.
- N. The E- Governance report for the year 2022-2023 has been approved by the Governing Body.
