Criteria 7.3.1:

Pragjyotish College, established on 1st September 1954, seven years after independence, became a beacon of learning and a symbol of aspirations for the common people of Assam, raring to build a new nation. At present, it is a well-known full-fledged under-graduate college imparting higher education in multiple streams.

Situated on the western bank of the Bharalu, a rivulet, in the western part of Guwahati, Pragjyotish College is about 1 kilometre away from its confluence with the mighty Brahmaputra. It is about 4 kilometres from the Guwahati Railway Station and at a distance of about 20 kilometres from the Lokapriya Gopinath Bordoloi International Airport. At the backdrop of the college is a beautiful panoramic view of Nilachal Hills, the famous abode of Mother Goddess Kamakhya.

In the emblem of the college, is insgrained the motto "तेजसिपराधीतमस्तु" (May our study make us illumined) and a conch shell at the centre on an eight-petalled full-blown beautiful lotus, which symbolizes pure knowledge and the relationship between the teacher and the learner, praying to the Almighty for energy, protection, maintenance that ultimately leads to peace and bliss.

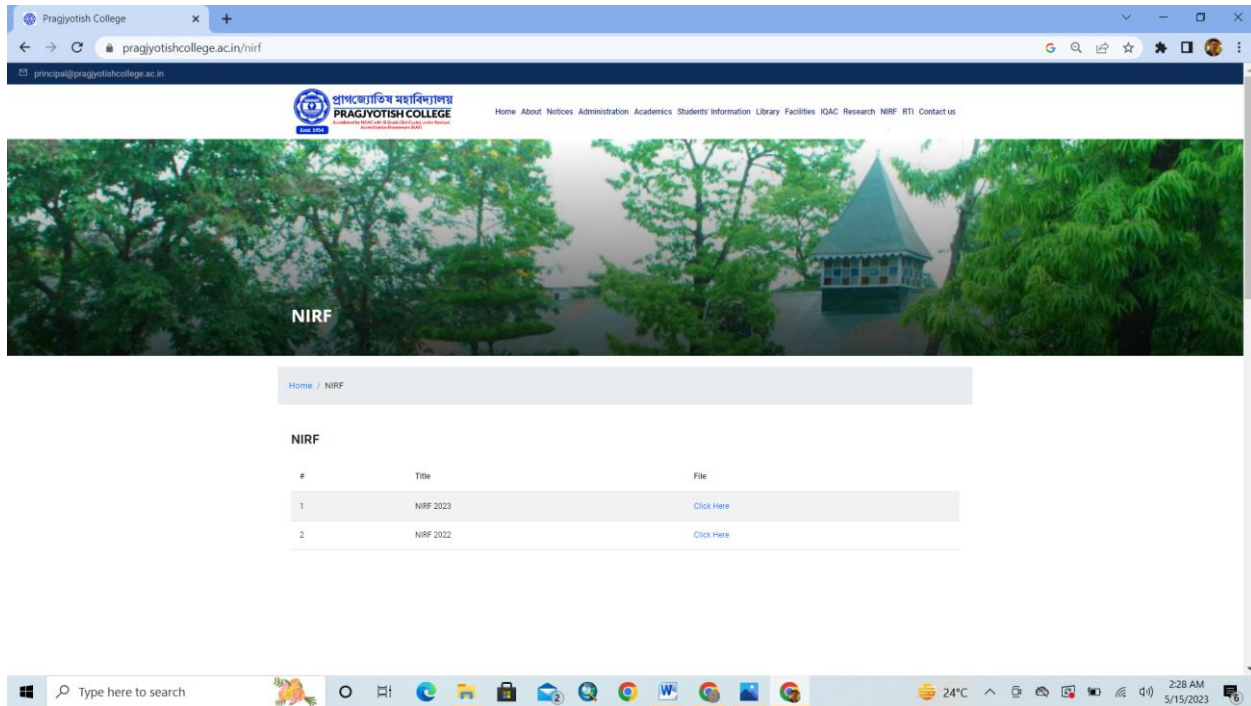

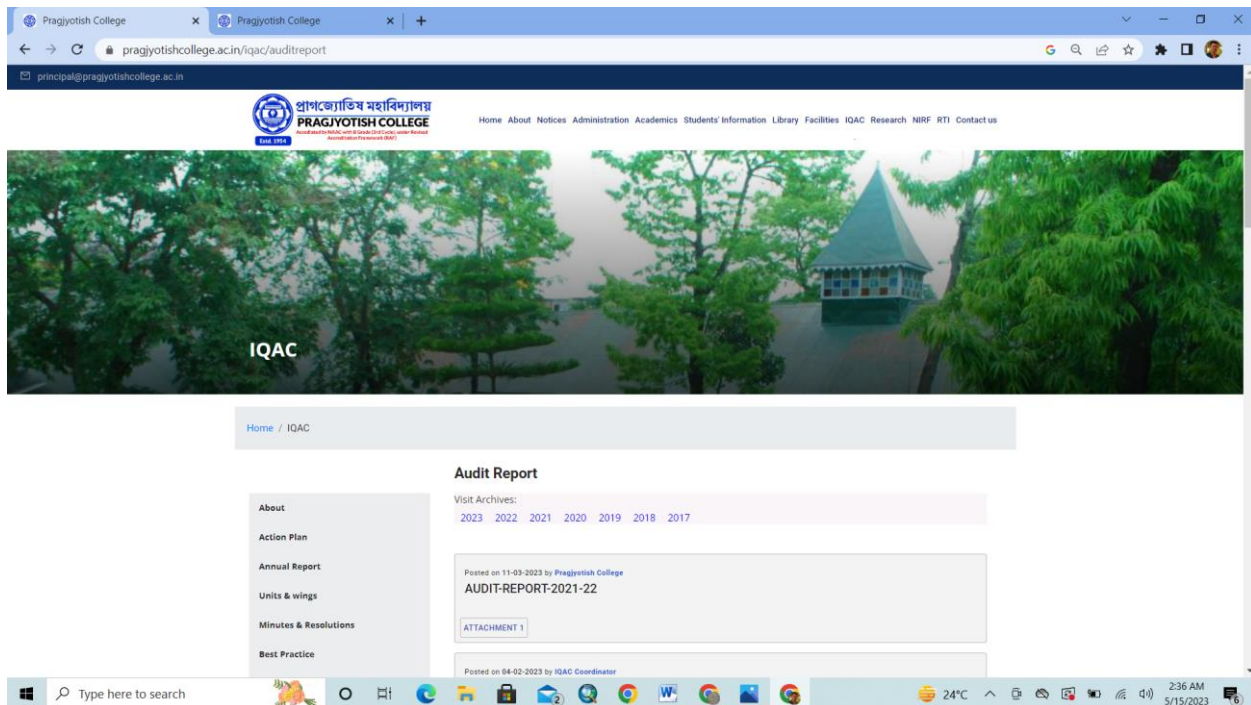

Home / Admission Procedure

General Information for Admission

- Admission in all programs is strictly in order of merit and is governed by the college admission rules, implemented through the Admission Committee (2020-21 Session). All decisions of the Admission Committee regarding admission matters will be final and binding.
- Admission Procedure (Govt. Guidelines):** In accordance with the Office Memorandum No. AHE. 639/2018/17, dated 10.06.2020, of the Higher Education Department, Govt. of Assam, there shall be no face interview, document verification etc. for admission during the academic session 2020-21. Mark-sheets, Certificates and all other relevant documents will be scanned and uploaded for the admission process by the students. All students will have to upload bank details, including IFSC, Bank Name, Branch and Mobile Number while applying for admission to avail the benefit of schemes like scholarship, reimbursement of hostel mess dues, textbook grants, etc. from the Govt.
- Admission against Reserved Categories: This is done as per rules and guidelines stipulated by the Govt. However, it will not be applicable in the allocation of Honours subjects. Reservation of seats for the different programs will be done as per the break-up given below:

Reservation against Extra-curricular Activities: For securing admission against this category, a candidate should provide testimonials to establish that he/ she have participated in any sports/ games/ cultural etc. event not below State level.

- Standardization of Marks:** To standardize the marks obtained by candidates of various boards, the Admission Committee shall follow the following procedure for preparing merit lists in various programs.
 - B.A. / B.Sc. / B.Com Programs: Any four subjects (excepting Physical Education/ Entrepreneurship/ Vocational** subjects) in which the candidate has obtained better marks in the 12th standard examination
 - H.S. Programs: As per aggregate marks

(**N.B. : A subject that contains 30% Theory + 70% Practical is considered as a Vocational subject)

- College Prospectus:** College Prospectus will be available in the college website and can be downloaded FREE of cost. College Prospectus/ Admission Forms in hard copy format will NOT be issued from the college office.

Right to Information

Right to Information (RTI) Act, 2005 mandates timely response to citizens' requests for government information. The basic object of the Right to Information Act is to empower the citizens, promote transparency and accountability in the working of the government. Fees

A citizen who desires to seek some information from The PIO (Public Information Officer) is required to send, along with the application (a Postal order or DD (Demand draft) or a bankers cheque) payable to The Principal, Pragjyotish College, Guwahati as fee prescribed for seeking information. If the person is from a disadvantaged community, he/she need not pay. The applicant may also be required to pay further fees towards the cost of providing the information, details of which shall be intimated to the applicant by the PIO as prescribed by the RTI ACT, 2005.

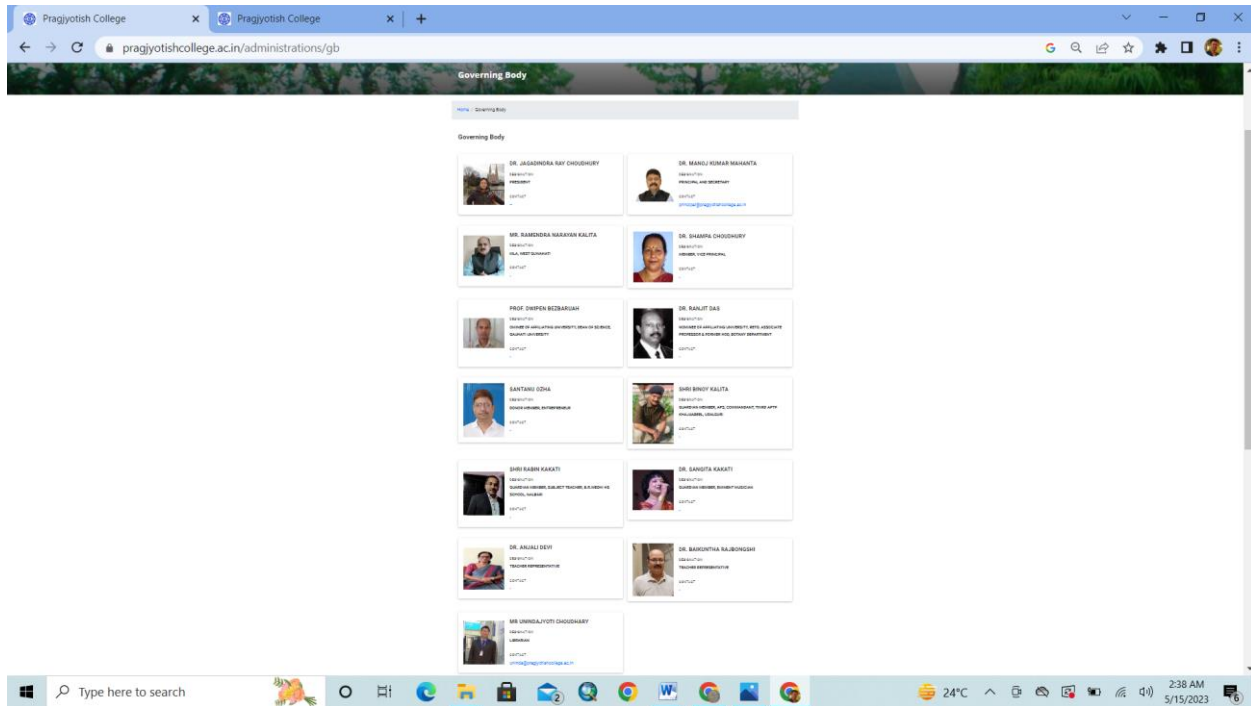

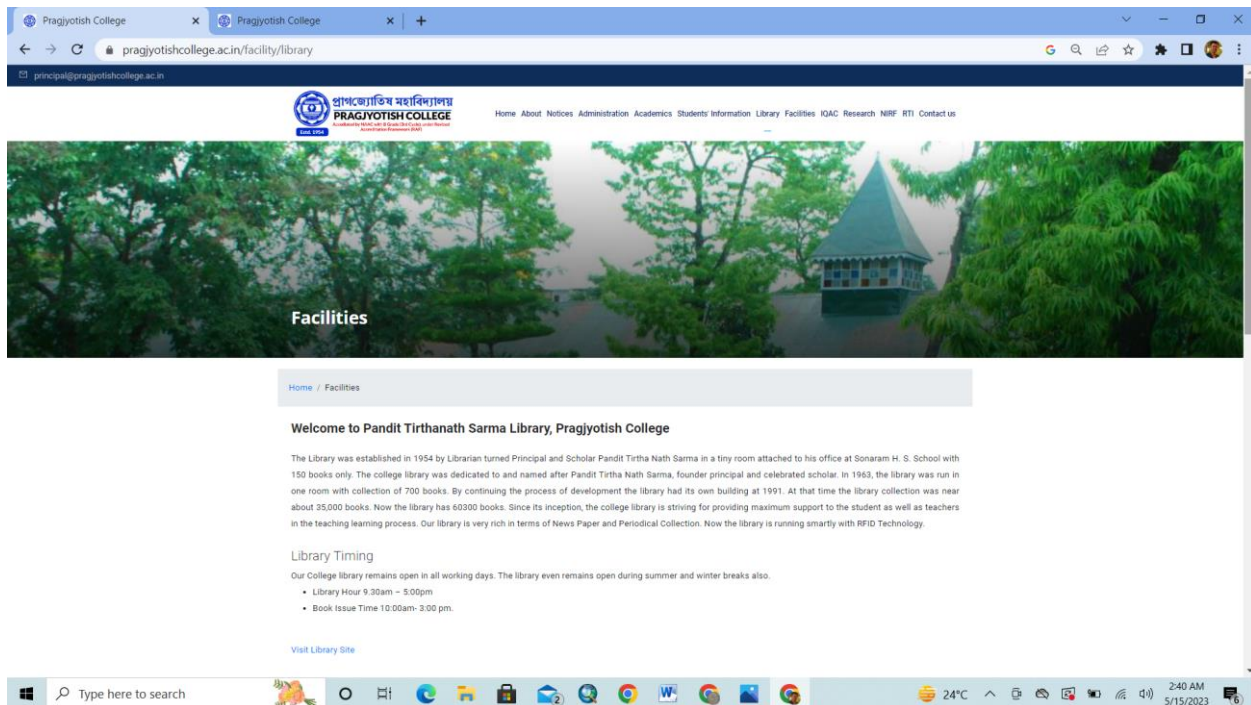
